INSTRUCTIONS FOR HRMO SCREENING (including MRSA)



This pack contains the materials for screening for HRMO (Highly Resistant Microorganisms) and MRSA bacteria.

Contents of the pack

- · Five collection sets consisting of a swab and a tube filled with a culture medium
- A safety bag (plastic bag with an adhesive strip at the top)
- A blister pack (plastic box)
- A zipped return envelope or a return box
- Information leaflet entitled 'Screening for MRSA and other HRMO'
- Five labels with the source of the sample on them
- One (green) request form for microbiological testing

Sampling using the swabs

- Open the package and remove the tube.
- Remove the swab. <u>Grip the swab at the upper end to take the sample, not below</u> the coloured breaking point. Collect the material as shown in the following diagram.

| MRSA | Nose | Swirl one swab around the inside of both nostrils using a firm rotating action |
|-----------|----------|-------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| MRSA | Throat | Brush the swab over the back of the throat along the throat wall, around the tonsil area |
| MRSA | Perineum | Brush the swab over the skin between the anus and genitals |
| MRSA/HRMO | Wound | Run a swab through the wound |
| HRMO | Rectum | Insert the swab in your anus or pass the swab through your stool The swab should be discoloured |

- 3. Open the tube and insert the swab.
- 4. Break off the swab at the coloured breaking point.
- 5. Screw the cap onto the tube. Tighten the cap securely to prevent leakage.
- 6. Write the following on all tubes: your name, date of birth and the collection date.
- 7. Stick the label on the tube showing the source of the sample below those details.

Completing the request form for microbiological testing

- The patient's details (name, date of birth, address).
- Collection date.
- If you have a wound, tick wound under the heading 'Additional materials' and indicate the location of the wound.

Procedure for submitting the swabs and a request form

- Put the swabs in the blister pack (plastic box) and press it tightly shut.
- Put the filled blister pack into the safety bag and seal it using the adhesive strip (pull away white strip, press front and back).
- Put the safety bag and the request form in the return envelope or return box.
- Zip up the return envelope.
- Fold the return box, using adhesive tape if necessary.

You can hand in the return envelope or return box in any of the following ways:

- By post (a stamp is not required) or
- Handing it in at the reception desk of the blood collection department of the various sites of the Albert Schweitzer hospital or
- By taking it directly to the RLM.
